The outdoorsy-inclined members meet at Kletzsch Park (43°08'22"N 87°55'28"W) on the Milwaukee River in Glendale, a northern suburb of Milwaukee. Kletzsch Park has long been known for its colony of *Helix pomatia*, the European escargot. The species is believed to have been introduced intentionally on an island upstream from the park "as a source of food by an epicure." The introduction of *Helix* occured more than 100 years ago and it has recently been confirmed that the colony still persists. We will meet at the parking lot.
