The more adventurous of us can hike up Centennial trail a bit and search in the river there and the adjacent woods. Time permitting we might drive to another site, possibly on the Illinois & Michigan Canal later.

Coming on I 55, exit either at Exit 269 and go south on Joliet Rd. which merges with State Rte. 53, or exit at Exit 267 and go directly south on 53. Stay on 53 until you reach the intersection with Romeo Rd./135th St. Make a left turn here and go east for less than a mile. Isle de la Cache Museum and Preserve is on the right of the road.

To get to White Fence Farm, return to 53 on 135th St. Turn right on 53 which becomes Joliet Rd. Continue to the restaurant.
